### **The policy of "Jurczak" Jacek Jurczak Production-Commercial-Service Company on raw materials from areas affected by armed conflicts**

The company PPHU JURCZAK supports the initiative of international organizations and companies in the field of not acquiring raw materials from countries affected by armed conflicts. These minerals include tantalum, gold, tin, and tungsten, which are common used in the world and are used to finance armed groups in these countries.

We are against the use of materials from conflict zones and dubious or of unknown origin.

The company PPHU JURCZAK does not order raw materials, goods and components directly from areas affected by armed conflicts.

We agree that social responsibility issues need to be addressed, along with the entire chain supply. We are aware that purchasing goods from our suppliers may be raw materials from the areas affected by armed conflicts, so we expect our suppliers to use only minerals derived from conflict-free areas. We make every effort to ensure that our suppliers' source material from sources that respect human and environmental protection rights.

PPHU JURCZAK encourages suppliers to fill in the uniform Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT) created by EICC / GeSI and request information on mineral extraction sources in their supply chains.

We expect our suppliers to implement safe mineral sourcing, due diligence procedures, send back the CMRT template promptly or make applicable declarations.
